One of the biggest projects she oversees is ensuring lower level students in our college are eligible to progress to upper level majors. She coordinates reporting that oversees hundreds plus student records in their class completion, GPA, and number of times attempting a course. Kim also coordinates students coming from other departments (UCOL, CLAS, etc) into the Belk College. This includes open communication with college liaisons, checking student eligibility, inputting notes, and conducting in person introductions to the college. Impressively, Kim was able to turn this typical in person process to an online format during the university's remote operating procedures. She took this a step further and has started an online canvas course to allow students to complete this process online. The innovation will allow a more seamless, convenient process for students to enter our college Due to staff turnover, our staff had to take on extra duties and projects this semester. Kim happily stepped up to help and has completed several tasks that are not part of her normal job duties. This included overseeing a new transfer canvas module training program that allowed new students to get more information about our policies and the registration process. She also oversees a large caseload of 600+ students which requires a packed schedule to meet demands of student appointments, clearing students for graduation, and monitoring class need. Kim is a team player who brings positivity and a fun sense of humor to our students and team! You can always count on her to volunteer to help and offer feedback to move our team forward.
