[Presentation](#) - Mr. Lape shared stats on parking demands and peak times and locations. The busiest decks are Union Lower, West and East 2 & 3. The campus community is encouraged to use any of the mitigation tools offered by PaTS; Variable Message Boards, Parking Ambassadors, Parking Availability Web-Page/App, Niner Transit Bus GPS and PaTS Consultant.

Future plans include dynamic digital signage at campus entrances, parking availability for lots added to the current app, and a parking guidance system that will direct parkers inside busiest decks to available spaces.

No New Parking Decks! - the TDM (transportation demand management) consultants will incentivize people to not bring their vehicle to campus but to carpool, rideshare, etc.. Also considering tweaking class schedules to help balance campus congestion.

Parking rates have increased \$30 in the last 14 years. PaTS generates its own revenue with no subsidy from tuition or State money.

FedEx Office Print & Copy will open in Lower Prospector in January/February. They will provide print/copy services, promotional items, large-format signs and graphics, project consultation, etc.

Dining Services - students are needed for staffing. Upper Prospector expansion allowed for service of 2-3 times as many meals as previously served. A Chick-fil-A renovation/expansion is coming.
